## **Nainital**

**65 Km.**

Nainital is a Himalayan resort town in the Kumaon region of India's Uttarakhand state, at an elevation of roughly 2,000m. Formerly a British hill station, it's set around Nainital Lake, a popular boating site with Naina Devi Hindu Temple on its north shore. A cable car runs to Snow View observation point (at 2,270m), with vistas over the town and mountains including Nanda Devi, Uttarakhand's highest peak.

## **Ranikhet**

**90 Km.**

Ranikhet is a hill station in Uttarakhand State, northern India. It's known for its views of the Himalayas. Hundreds of bells adorn Jhula Devi Temple, dedicated to the Hindu goddess Durga. Fruit trees grow on the terraced orchards of Chaubatia Gardens, with views of peaks including Nanda Devi. Mahatma Gandhi stayed in a hut, Gandhi Kuti, in nearby Tarikhet village during the independence struggle.



## **Hanuman Dham**

**20 Km.**

Located in the serene environment of the majestic Himalayan valley, Hanuman Dham gives you the perfect ambiance to delve deep into your inner self. It is named after Shri Hanuman Ji, the epitome of service. This Hanuman Dham will be the epitome of service and devotion. A center of service, devotion and dedication, devotees can live a peaceful life with complete holistic well-being at Hanuman Dham. This Dham will also be a cultural center promoting ancient Indian culture especially the culture of love and service of Devbhoomi Uttarakhand. Located on the banks of the Koshi River, this huge ashram is surrounded by lush green lawns, water bodies and fountains. It has a grand Hanuman temple, yoga-meditation hall, center for the differently abled, Vanaprastha Ashram, etc.

## **Garjiya Devi Temple**

**2 Km.**

Garjiya Devi Temple is a hindu Devi temple located in the Garjiya village 14 km north of the city Ramnagar, Uttarakhand, India, on the outskirts of the Corbett National Park. It is a sacred Shakti shrine where Garjiya Devi is the presiding deity.

## **Jim Corbett Museum**

**35 Km.**

Corbett Museum is a heritage site dedicated to Sir Edwar James Corbett, popularly known as Jim Corbett, showcasing his life through his work and belongings. This was the winter house of Jim Corbett where he lived along with his sister and dog, later it was converted to museum. Jim Corbett was a British Hunter who turned naturalist and conservationist during the times of British colonisation of India. Mr. Corbett had a strong influence on wildlife preservation that is why the first National Park of India was named after this legendary person. The Museum displays numerous belongings of Mr. Jim Corbett like his general shooting attire and letters.



## **The Dhangarhi Museum**

**10 Km.**

The Dhangarhi Museum is a prominent part of Jim Corbett National Park, located near the Dhangarhi Gate, which is the entry point to the park's famous Dhikala Zone. The museum is an excellent spot for visitors to explore before heading into the park, as it offers detailed insights into the park's wildlife, ecology, and the legacy of Jim Corbett, after whom the park is named.

The Dhangarhi Gate and Museum is one of the main entry points to Jim Corbett National Park in Uttarakhand, India. The gate serves as an access point for tourists heading into the park, while the adjacent museum offers insight into the history, wildlife, and legacy of the park, especially its connection to the legendary British hunter-turned-conservationist, Jim Corbett.
